Small boy: Cash, please

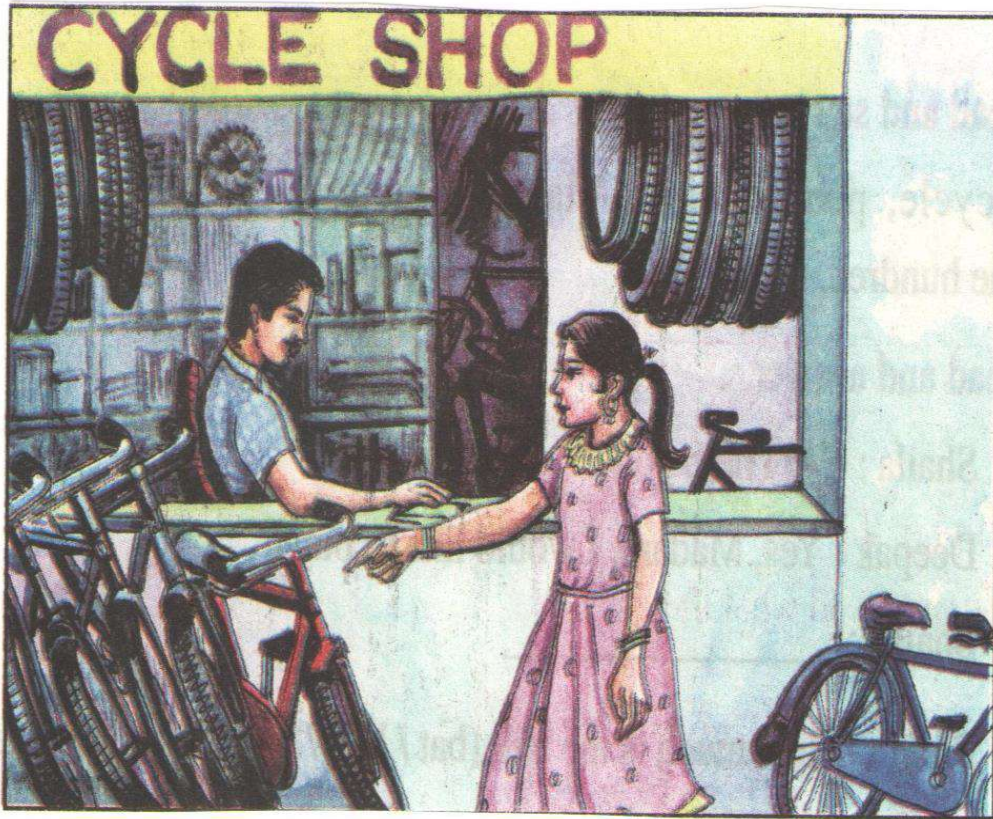
Ice-cream seller: Alright, enjoy your ice cream!
