- Sizes, colours, shapes, and qualities are all examples of adjectives.


REMEMBER:

We can make adjectives from nouns by:


- 1. By adding '-y' at the end of a noun. e.g., ice icy His icy hands could not be touched.
- 2. By adding '-ly' at the end of a noun. e.g., Friend friendly My friend Peter is friendly with everyone.
- 3. By adding '-ful' at the end of a noun. e.g., Beauty beautiful The garden looks very beautiful.
