Ronald: Yes, sure. Do you know the supermarket?

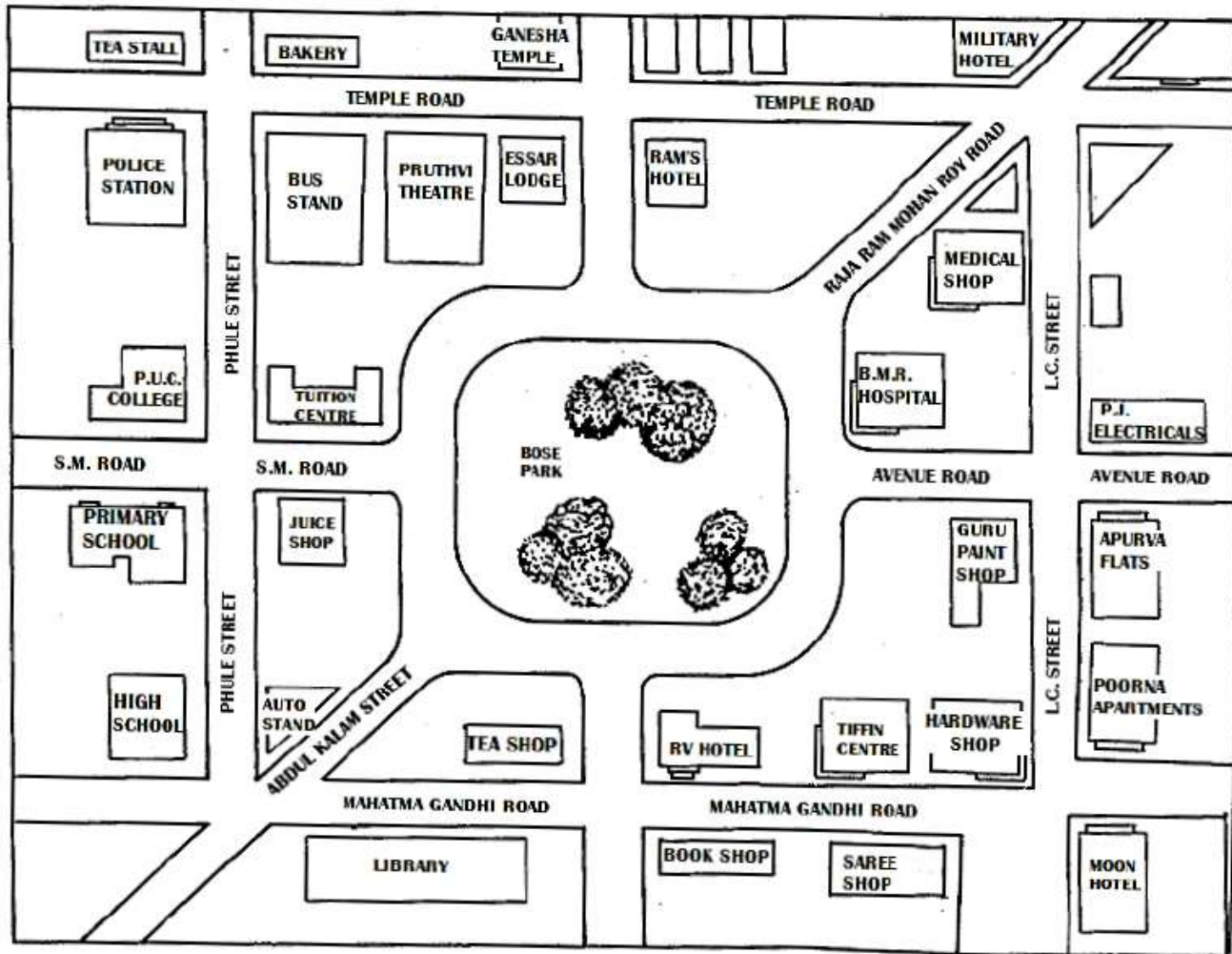
Sujatha: Yes.
