

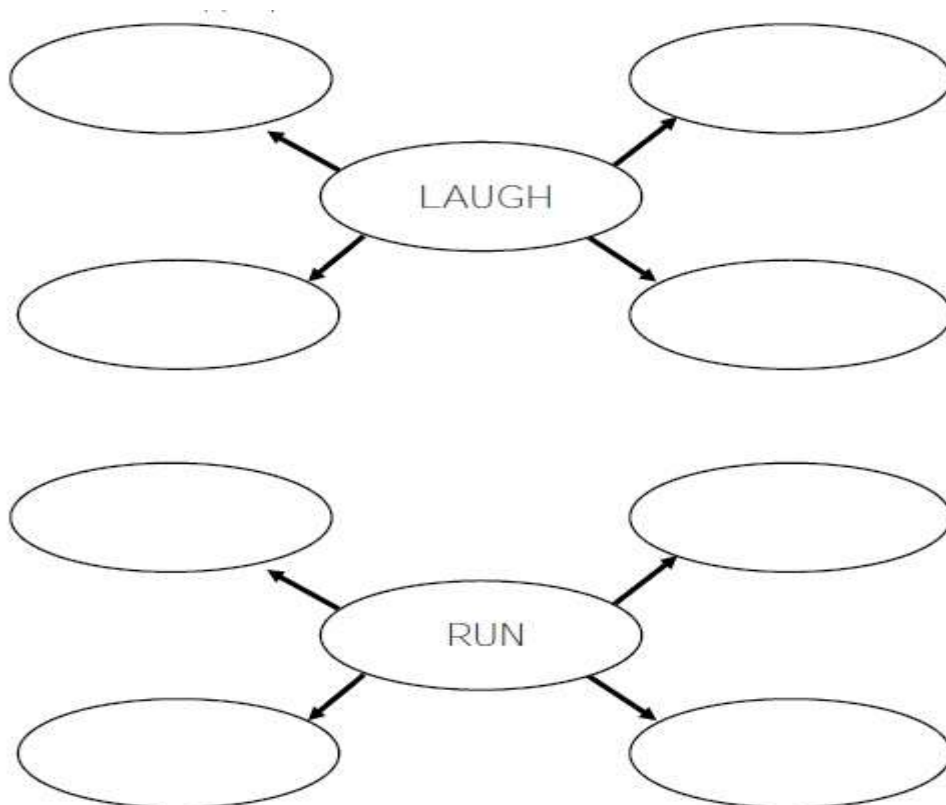

REMEMBER!

Prefixes and suffixes are a combination of 2 or more letters that are added to a word. While prefixes are added at the beginning of a word, suffixes are added at the end. Adding a prefix or suffix can change the meaning of the word to which it is added or make a new word.
