Prepositions can show the relationship between a noun or pronoun with other words in a sentence. They are used to show the time, or the movement in a sentence. Conjunctions are words that are used to join words, phrases, or clauses together.

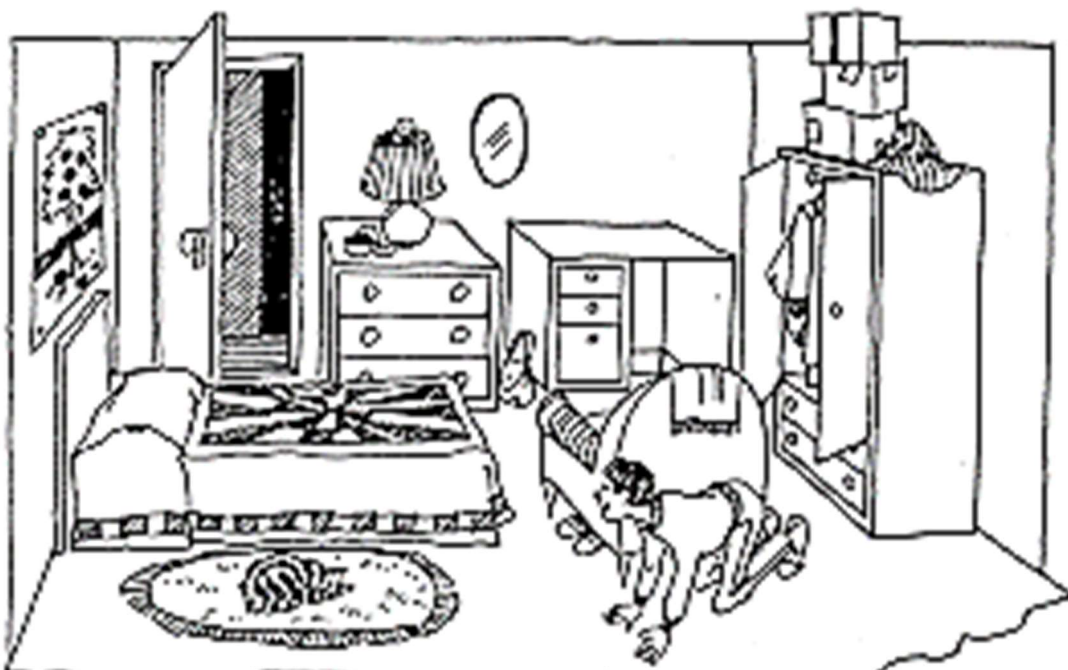
