b) Whom does 'You' refer to?

Answer: Jean Valjean

c) Why did he say this?

Answer: Tired and hungry, the convict asks the Bishop for help. After a hearty meal, the Bishop realizes the extent of the man's suffering.

- 7. "Good heavens! The silver is stolen."
- a) Who said this?

Answer: Baptistine

b) Who had stolen the silverware?

Answer: Jean Valjean

c) How had he stolen the silverware?

He went past the bed, straight to the cupboard. He saw the silverware, took it, and crossed the room.

- 8. "I was a man once, I'm a beast now."
- a) Who is the speaker?

Answer: Jean Valjean

b) Who does 'I' refer to?

Answer: Jean Valjean

c) Why had he became a beast?

b) Whom does 'Me'' refer to?

Answer: convict

c) Why he was chain up like a wild animal?

Answer: Because he had stolen some bread.
